

What are we doing

We are taking care of the waste water services in your community by upgrading a section of sewer on Station Road and Nairn Road in Ardersier which has been deteriorating and causing problems for customers.



- We are currently in the first phase of the project on Nairn Road.
- Works are expected to take around 1 year with reinstatement to follow.
- Road Closures are planned in 3 phases namely:
 - $\circ~$ On Station Road from the Nairn Road junction to number 26 Station Road
 - Entrance to lane adjacent to number 59 Nairn Road
 - Entrance to lane adjacent to number 33 Nairn Road behind number 17 Cameron Drive
- Residents car parking bays, where possible, will be kept open and additional spaces have been made available.





Our site compound (shown on map below) is situated to the rear of houses in Station Road and Nairn Road, at the far side of the football field from Ardersier Primary School. 13 additional car parking spaces have been made available for residents parking.





Progress, road closure and bus services

- We have established the site compound and additional car parking spaces; and installed all signage for the first phase of work.
- The main works are currently in progress on Nairn Road under traffic lights.
- The temporary road closure on Station Road will begin from Monday 3rd April 2023 and be in place for up to 12 weeks.
- During the road closure on Station Road, buses will be diverted along Stuart Street for entrance/egress from Ardersier. Bus stops on Nairn Road and Station Road will be temporarily closed.
- Anyone using the bus service (including School Pupils waiting to board the 111 Services) should use the bus stops on either **Stuart Street or Ardersier High Street.**


- Safer routes to school will be maintained for pupils walking to school during works.




Diversion route

The diversion route and signposting for all road traffic is shown below. Please follow the signs in place for the duration of the road closure.

Cones will be placed at the junction of Stuart Street with the High Street. We would ask residents and businesses to refrain from parking within the hatched box in order to allow space for vehicles turning right at this junction.

Local businesses and community facilities on Station Road will remain open and accessible via the diversion – please continue to support them.





Getting Around Safely

During works in Station Road and Nairn Road school pupils and pedestrians should use the routes shown below to avoid the construction works.



- Other pedestrian routes will remain open, including the normal safe route from Station Drive to the primary school. There will be little traffic on this section of Station Road during the road closure but please continue to cross with care – and also be aware when the road reopens in the summer and normal traffic returns.
