Improving Urban Waters in Nairn

What we are doing

We are upgrading the waste water system in your area to help manage heavy rainfall, protect your community from flooding and improve the water environment. To help plan our future works in this area we require to carry out some site investigation works within the car park outside Scotmid, Lochloy Road, Nairn. This work includes, trial hole excavations, manhole surveys and a borehole ground survey. See overleaf for details of the works.

When are we doing it

Work is planned to start from Monday 24th March and is expected to be completed within approximately 1 to 2 weeks

What happens next

- During the works there will be some restrictions to parking in the car park (details overleaf).
- Part of the works involves a survey to locate a buried manhole near the car park entrance. The manhole once found will be opened up to carry out surveys. The location of the manhole will determine whether or not we require any restrictions to the car park access. This part of the work will take approximately 1-2 days.
- The borehole and trial excavation works in the east side of the car park will take up approximately 6 spaces for around 3-5 days depending on progress.
- Working areas will be fenced off to ensure safety of workforce and car park users.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Our contractors AIM will be carrying out these works on our behalf. They will do all they can to keep disruption to a minimum.


Lochloy Road Car Park – Site Investigation Works

Approximate area for breaking out buried manhole.

- Approx. 2/3 spaces out of use here during this part of the SI works.
- Survey to locate the manhole will be carried out.
- Once location of manhole confirmed, we will confirm whether vehicle access to the car park can be maintained.
- This section of the works only expected to take 1-2 days

Approximate area for trial excavation and borehole works.

- Approx. 6 spaces out of use during this part of SI works.
- Likely be completed in 3-5 days depending on progress with the borehole works.
- Borehole trailer/rig will occupy this area for duration of the works.
