

Taking care of your Sewer Network in Pittenweem - Sewer Lining Works

Important Scottish Water Information

In previous communications regarding the recent East Shore works, we advised of some future sewer lining works that were to be carried out. This newsletter is to provide an update on the start date and details for the planned sewer lining works in East Shore & Mid Shore.

What is Sewer Lining?

The sewer lining works involve accessing the sewer via manholes at each end of the section to be lined. The sewer is then cleaned before inserting a liner into the pipe.

To carry out this work we require access at each manhole for the lining rig and jetting machine.

Planned Sewer Lining Works:

This programme of sewer lining involves lining the existing sewer from the start of East Shore along to Mid Shore (see overleaf for details).

Dates and Duration:

The lining works are planned to start on **Monday 25**th **November 2024** and the full programme of work is expected to take approximately **2 weeks**.

Please note these dates include working over the weekend 30th November/1st December.

Work Phasing:

The lining works have been split into 3 phases. With each phase having its own date and duration. (See overleaf for location details of each phase).

Phase 1 − 25th November for approx. 4 days

Phase 2 – 29th November for approx. 4 days

Phase 3 – 2nd December for approx. 6 days

Parking Restrictions:

In order to carry out these works as efficiently as possible we require sufficient space at each manhole for the lining equipment.

Because of this there will be parking restrictions (no parking) in certain areas during the works. These will be coned off ahead of each phase and we kindly ask for your assistance in not parking in these areas during the works.

We will assess each area as we are working and free up any space we can as we go.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Traffic Management:

Localised temporary traffic lights will be in place during each phase of works also. Please follow all signs in place.

Our contractors Environmental Techniques are carrying out these works on our behalf. They will do all they can to keep any disruption to a minimum.
