

Taking care of your Sewer Network in Pittenweem – Project Update.

Important Scottish Water Information

We are investing in and upgrading the sewer network to help reduce sewer flooding and protect the local environment. This newsletter is to provide a further update on progress as we continue the sewer improvement works and head towards the completion of our work in East Shore.

Update:

East Shore Works: The works are now complete including the new sea outfall in the outer harbour.

The Gyles outfall abandonment and remaining reinstatement works: We do have some minor works still to be completed. This includes the abandonment of the small outfall pipe at The Gyles, and some reinstatement works in the same area.

Additional Sewer Lining Works: Whilst not part of the East Shore Project, Scottish Water have identified the need for sewer lining works in the area. This is between approx. No.5 East Shore to near the end of Mid Shore.

We had hoped to be able to carry out this work at the same time as the East Shore works, however logistical challenges and unavoidable changes to the work sequencing prevented us from being able to do so.

Additional Sewer Lining Works (cont.): The current programme will see this additional lining works take place around Mid-September and will take approximately 2 weeks.

The lining works involves accessing manholes to install the liner and will require some restrictions to parking around each manhole for approximately 2-3 days each to allow the lining equipment to be set up.

During this same time, we plan to carry out the remaining reinstatement works and outfall abandonment at The Gyles.

We will write to you again with full details once everything has been confirmed nearer the time.

All areas will be clear ahead of the upcoming Pittenweem Arts Festival, including the site compound area next to the cemetery. We have been liaising with the festival committee throughout and thank them for their assistance.

We would also like to thank all residents for your patience, co-operation and understanding whilst we carried out these essential works.
