

Taking care of your Sewer Network in Pittenweem – Project Update.

Important Scottish Water Information

We are investing in and upgrading the sewer network to help reduce sewer flooding and protect the local environment. This newsletter is to provide a further update on remaining reinstatement works required on our sewer improvement work in East Shore.

These remaining works are due to be carried out from **Monday 16**th **September** and are expected to be completed within **approx. 1-2 weeks**.

Remaining Reinstatement Works:

East Shore:

- Minor works required at the manhole outside No5 East Shore. These works will require an area (approx. 1 car length) to be barriered off for approx. 1-2 days.
- Installation of a small cabinet at footpath next to the harbour wall adjacent to the new CSO chamber. Small area will be barriered off for approx. 1-2 days.

The Gyles:

- Outfall abandonment: Work at manhole located at the small slipway outside No5 the Gyles to survey and abandon the small outfall pipe. This will require the existing manhole to be broken out to access the outfall pipe. Area will be barriered off for approx. 2-3 days.
- Outer Harbour Area: Some additional small reinstatement works required around the outer harbour area.

 Road Reinstatement: Some small remedial works required in the road at The Gyles.

Additional Sewer Lining Works:

We previously advised of some additional sewer lining works to be done between approx. No.5 East Shore to near the end of Mid Shore. This work was initially planned for around Mid-September. These works have now been rescheduled and will now take place towards the end of November/start of December. We will write again nearer the time with full details once confirmed.

General Information:

Our contractors APL will be carrying out the remaining works on our behalf.

We would also like to thank all residents for your patience, co-operation and understanding whilst we carried out these essential works.
