Taking care of your sewer network in Windhill / Muir of Ord.

What we are doing

We are taking care of the sewer network in your community by upgrading sewers in Windhill / Muir of Ord to help reduce the risk of sewer flooding by reducing the risk of pipes bursting. This work involves the construction of a new sewer from the existing Windhill pumping station off the A862 to the south east side of Muir of Ord (See overleaf for details of works location and pipe route).

When are we doing it

Work is planned to start week commencing Monday 25th November 2024 and is expected to take approximately 30 weeks.

What happens next

- Works to construct approx. 1.7km of new sewer will be carried out on a rolling basis starting from Windhill pumping station off the A862.
- Most of the works will be carried out in private / rural land. All working areas will be securely fenced off to ensure the safety of the public and our site team.
- There are two sections where we cross the A862. These sections will be carried out by drilling the new pipe underneath the road. This will mean there will be no disruption to traffic on the A862.
- There is a section of work along the access road to the south of the industrial estate where we require to install the pipe along the road. Our site team will liaise with anyone affected regards vehicle access and pedestrian access.
- During the works there may be noise from construction activities as we construct the new sewer.
- Our contractor Pat Munro Construction Ltd. will be carrying out this work on our behalf and they will do all they can to keep disruption to a minimum as much as possible.

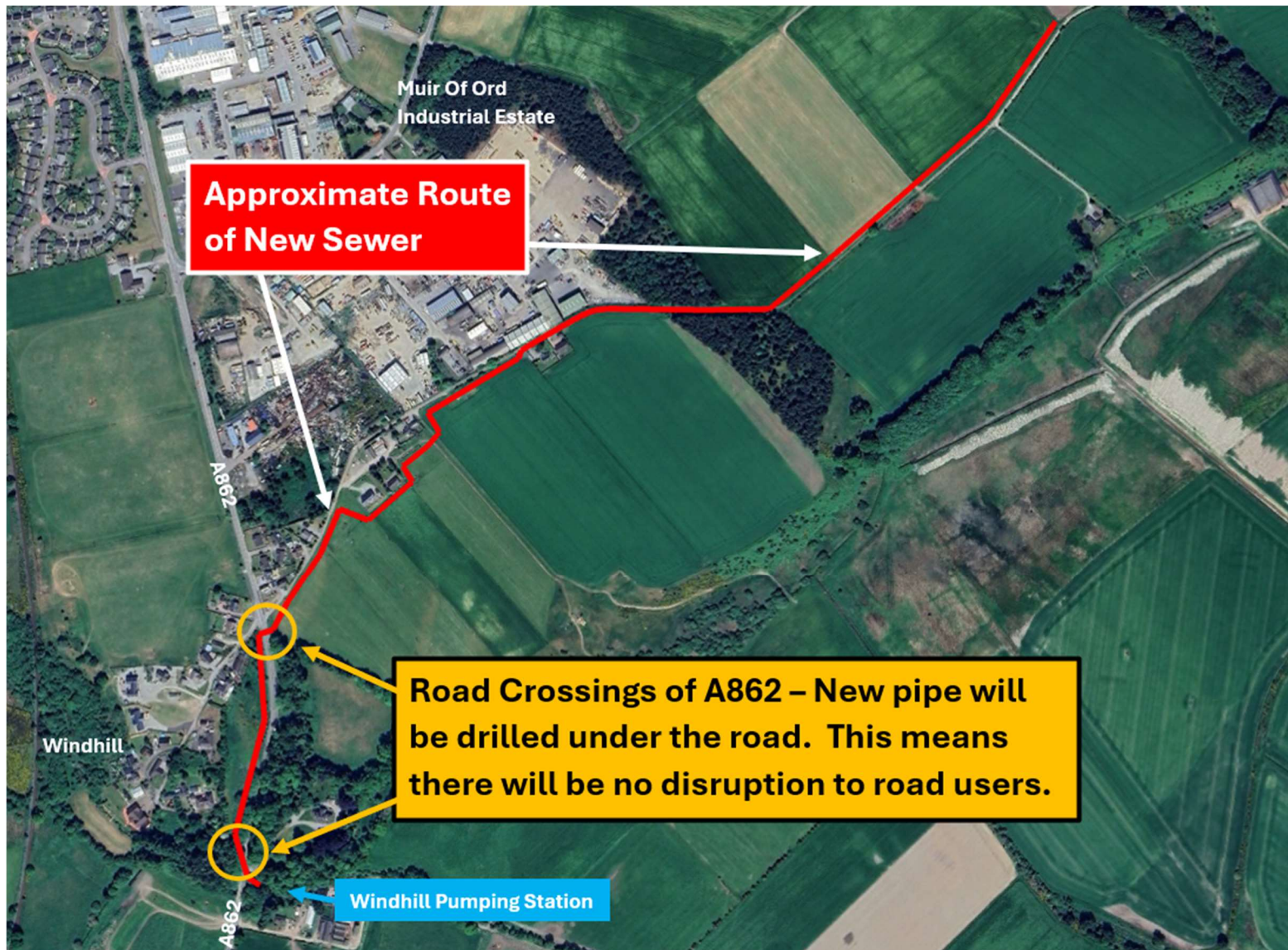
